There are many ways to do this project. Some ideas are listed here, but you may choose to create your own masterpiece. The goal is to represent a story or a symbol of the Bible in 3D form. Once you have completed your project, explain its significance either in a brief essay with photos or a short video presentation.

Ideas include, but are not limited to, the following:

- 1.** Create a model of the tabernacle
- 2.** Build one of the pieces of furniture from the tabernacle (does not necessarily have to be built to scale)
- 3.** Construct a model of Noah's ark
- 4.** Create a diorama depicting a scene from the Bible
- 5.** Sew a replica of Joseph's coat of many colors
- 6.** Make a collage, mobile, or creative timeline (with or without dates) depicting the Seven Churches of Revelation, the plagues of Egypt
- 7.** Make a model of the statue of Daniel 2
- 8.** Create a model of one of the prophetic beasts of Daniel or Revelation
