- a) Babysit younger siblings so your mom can have some quiet time to herself.
- b) Fix a nice meal for everyone in your home without being told.
- c) Make a care package to send to someone who needs encouragement.
- d) Have a video chat or phone call with a person who might need encouragement.
- e) Clean or organize a part of your house that has been forgotten (every house has one of these).
- f) Read the Bible aloud to someone – either in person or on the phone.
- g) Volunteer to help with a project for your church, field, or union.
