



## Challenge Title

Videography

### Age Group

#### 4-7 years

**1.** Identify and explain the three areas of the Sanctuary in a short 2-minute video. Ask someone to help you with the recording by using either a smartphone or a camera.

#### 8-12 years

**1.** Record an interview with someone in video format about the Sanctuary by using a smartphone or camera. The video should not be longer than five minutes and should include the following:

- a.** an explanation about why the Sanctuary is still relevant in our time
- b.** an explanation about what the Sanctuary door represents
- c.** conclude by asking your participant to name the three parts of the Sanctuary and the furniture found in each part

#### 13-18 years

**1.** Film a narrative about the Sanctuary, based on your study of Exodus 25:8-9. It should be from 5-15 minutes long.

We believe that, in the times of the Old Testament, the Sanctuary constituted the center of congregation to worship. It was formerly found in the 'tent of the testimony', and then, in the temple. The worldly Sanctuary was divided in three areas, the court, the Holy place and the Holy of Holies place. Offerings were brought into the court. (Hebrews 9:1-7) Through the blood of the sacrifices, sin was trespassed to the Sanctuary, and it became unclean as a result of this. The sin offerings pointed out Jesus, "...the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world." (John 1:29, last part). The priests were merely chosen as mediators between God and men.

- 2.** Record your explanation, interview, or narrative in video format, with the following specs: horizontally and in HD – 1260x720.
- 3.** Send the video via email or WhatsApp to the Education leader or the Children's Sabbath School teacher of your local church. (If there is none, send it to the team of the Education Department of the GC.)
